The in-text and reference list citations follow the APA citation style: https://apastyle.apa.org
Each work cited must appear in the reference list, and each work in the reference list must be cited in the text (or in a table, figure, footnote, or appendix).
Both paraphrases and quotations require citations.

In-text citations

Identify the primary source and write "as cited in" the secondary source that you used.

Parenthetical: (Chaney, 1982, as cited in Lyon et al., 2014)

Narrative: Richards (1990, as cited in Goldsmith, 2009); Allport's diary (as cited in Nicholson, 2003)

References

Provide an entry for the secondary source only (not for the primary source).

WEBPAGE

In-text citations

Parenthetical: (Bologna, 2019) Narrative: Bologna (2019)

WEBSITE

Do not create references or in-text citations for whole websites.

To mention a website in general, and not any particular information on that site, provide the name of the website in the text and include the URL in parentheses.
